



CHS MANAGER - HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE STORAGE

COMMUNITY RIGHT TO KNOW HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE MANAGER (CHS)

We suggest registering for 'public user' access in the CHS Manager portal. The most current hazardous substance storage information is available to access directly 24 hours a day through the CHS Manager. Hazardous substance storage information records are only retained for 5 years, which is the timeframe required by law.

You can register for the CHS Manager - Hazardous Substance Storage online portal as a member of the public.

TO FIND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (HAZMAT) INCIDENTS

Hazmat incidents can be searched using our two online resources. Hazmat incident records are required by law to be retained forever, with the records beginning in 1985.

There are two separate online resources for Hazmat Incidents:

- Records that occurred between 1985 to 2009
- Records that occurred between 2010 to the current month

The Community Right to Know Hazardous Substance Manager (CHS) is the online portal for Oregon facilities to submit an annual hazardous substance inventory reports.

Any facility that stores a hazardous substance at a reportable quantity is required to submit an annual report. Members of the public can create profiles in the CHS Manager to view hazardous substances in their community.
